



This has been an exciting year at Metro; the new Auraria Science Building has been completed, and is providing classroom and laboratory space for students. Metro State gained approval to move forward with the Student Success Building and Hotel Learning Center. The Student Success Building will be the first in the Metro State Neighborhood and will include a central quad, pathways, courtyard, and gathering areas. It will house all of Metro State's student support services and provide additional classroom space; completion is expected by April 2012. The Hotel Learning Center will include a 200 room hotel, conference center, restaurant, and will provide academic space for the department of Hospitality, Tourism, and Events. When completed it will be only one of 11 such facilities in the country.

Handbook Updates:

We are no longer offering Surveying and Mapping degree.

Metro State now offers Masters Program in Accountancy, Social Work and Teacher Education, there is a 3+2 pathway in Accountancy and Social Work for students to complete both a bachelors and masters degree in five years.

Admissions:

Application deadline for spring semester is December 15 for regular admit students. Fall 2011 deadline will be July 1st for regular admit students.

Admissions Criteria: Students with an 85 or above index and who have met HEAR requirements will likely be admitted, these students will not need to submit any supporting materials.

Student with an index of 76-84 or who have not meet HEAR will be processed through our admissions review category; their file will be evaluated on an individual basis. **Please encourage students who fall into this category to submit a personal essay and letters of recommendation.** *Admissions deadline for admissions review students is different than regular admit students. These deadlines will be updated on our website.*

Transfer Students: If the student is 19 years or younger and is a Transfer student he/she will need to have completed ALL remedial courses or meet the ACT/SAT cut-score for Accuplacers. If the student does not meet these requirements he/she will be denied or will be reviewed under our Admissions Review category.

Tuition/Financial Aid: Metro State is committed to remaining affordable and accessible to all. Our tuition and fees for full-time students with the College Opportunity Fund is approximately \$2046, Non-Resident Tuition is \$7220, and Extended Campus tuition is \$2370

Location: Our main campus is just a few steps from the heart of downtown Denver; the city provides our students many cultural and recreational opportunities, as well as the advantage of building relationships and connections with area employers, businesses, and the community. This year, we will be hosting two Metro State Open House programs, the first on Saturday November 6th, and in the spring on Saturday April 2nd from 10:00a.m to 2:00p.m.. The Open House program is FREE, and offers students and parents the opportunity to take a campus tour, speak with professors, and learn about admission, financial aid and scholarships. Also campus tours are offered on a daily basis for individuals or groups you can access our website or call our office for a detailed schedule and to sign up.
