**New Programs:** In the fall of 2011 we are planning on starting a culinary arts program. This is the second year of our wind energy technician program.

**New Sports:** This year we started men's and women's golf. In the fall of 2011 we are going to start men's soccer and women's softball.

### **New Facilities:**

Northeastern 18: In the past year the Sterling Country Club was purchased and donated to the college. Northeastern now owns and operations the Northeastern 18 golf course and the Plainsman Grill. To find out more go to: <http://www.njc.edu/northeastern18/>.

Blue Spruce Hall: Northeastern is the largest residential two year school in Colorado with around 500 students living on campus. In the fall of 2011 we will have a new dorm constructed that will hold another 125 students on campus.

**Scholarship Information:** Our scholarship deadline is March 1, 2011. Students from Northeastern's 5 county service area (Logan, Washington, Phillips, Sedgwick, and Yuma) can qualify for the HOPE scholarship with a high school GPA of 2.5. Students from other Colorado high schools can qualify for the VISION scholarship with a high school GPA of 3.75. This scholarship works with grants to pay for up to half a student's tuition over two years. If students don't qualify right out of high school, they can qualify after their first semester at NJC with a 3.0 GPA or by spending 50 hours in our free tutoring center.

**Programs with Limited Enrollment:** Over the last couple of years we have had to limit the number of students who wanted to study nursing, equine management, cosmetology, and wind energy technology. It is important students apply early to be accepted into these programs.

**Visiting Campus:** Students can set up individual visits any day of the week. We are hosting Discovery Day open house events on November 12, February 21, and April 15. If you have a group that would like to visit we can accommodate them on a Discovery Day or plan a unique visit for your group.

**What is NJC:** Northeastern is the largest residential two year school in the state. With the benefits of smaller class sizes and lower tuition students can succeed in the classroom, while still having a great college experience. With over 1,000 students and 500 living in the residence halls students have the opportunity to meet others from all over, get involved in clubs and organizations, and cheer on the Plainsmen athletic teams. Northeastern also offers an honors program taught by a former Fortune 500 executive who is now the college president. This combination has allowed NJC to have some of the highest graduation and retention rates compared to other two year schools.
