- This past spring, our students passed a multimillion dollar expansion referendum which will allow for an 18,000 square foot addition to the College Center on the Pueblo campus, enhancing current student services and adding additional support services.
- **Business and Technology:**
- News from B&T:
 - We now offer an Interior Design program and Energy Maintenance program.
 - The Energy Maintenance program has a Solar and Wind Turbine Technician option.
- **Health Professions:**
 - We also have the first polysomnography program in the state of Colorado. This is a sleep technician certificate.
 - Please note that most of our health programs do have limited enrollment and we encourage students to begin pre-requisites as soon as possible.
 - We have a dental and healthcare clinic on our main campus employing a full time doctor and dentist to provide clinical opportunities for students.
- **Arts and Sciences:**
 - As with all community colleges, students can begin their first two years towards a bachelor's degree at PCC. We offer AA degrees that prepare students for four year degrees in Elementary Education, Secondary Education, Engineering, and Business to name a few. PCC has strong working relationships with various universities including CSU-Pueblo and have signed articulation agreements to ensure that our students have seamless transfer experiences between our institutions.

High School Outreach Program and Shadow Information:

- The Pueblo campus will be hosting a Day/Night college fair on November 8th from 10-11:30 a.m.
- We do offer many program options for concurrent enrollment students to help them get ahead.
- Because we pride ourselves in personalized service, we offer tailored campus tours depending on program of interest and can also offer an experience to shadow a student. This can be arranged through the Office of Recruitment.

Scholarships:

- The Foundation now offers over 150 scholarships. Applications are fully online and paperless. They are available the beginning of January each year and the due date is usually the second week in April. You may find the application by visiting our website and selecting scholarships on the quick links menu.
- PCC has implemented a FAFSA deadline in August to encourage students to be proactive in their college preparation. The Office of Recruitment will help any senior to complete the FAFSA who is planning to attend PCC next fall. This can be done in the spring semester after students and their parents have filed their 2010 income tax returns.
