Thank you for your interest in applying for membership to the Colorado Council on High School/College Relations. This not-for-profit volunteer organization has been serving the educational needs of Colorado high school students since 1949.

ELIGIBILITY FOR MEMBERSHIP

Institutions, organizations or individuals seeking membership to the Colorado Council must fall in one of the three categories outlined below:

A. K-12 SCHOOLS

Public and charter schools: Any school operated by a school district within the State of Colorado.
Private Schools: Any private or parochial school, whose main campus is in Colorado, and which is owned and operated by a duly recognized corporation or organization authorized by the State of Colorado for the purpose of educating people and accredited by the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools or a recognized agency approved by the Executive Committee.

B. INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING

Nonprofit Institutions of Higher Learning that operate a campus in Colorado and that are accredited by one of the following agencies: Middle States Association of Schools and Colleges, New England Association of Schools and Colleges, North Central Association of Colleges and Schools, Northwest Association of Schools and Colleges, Southern Association of Schools and Colleges, Western Association of Schools and Colleges:

- Two-year junior or community colleges offering Associate of Arts, Associate of Science, or Associate of General Studies degrees whose credits transfer to Colorado Council member colleges and universities.
- Colleges or universities offering baccalaureate or higher degrees whose credits transfer to Colorado Council member colleges and universities.

C. ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP

The Colorado Council provides associate membership for those organizations or individuals whose purpose is to assist Colorado students in the transition from high school to college, but who are not in themselves institutions of learning. Applicants should address how they:

- a. provide assistance to high school students in their transition to college
- b. collect and disseminate pertinent information for college-bound students
- c. cooperate with non-profit organizations, schools and colleges in the transition process

Associate membership does not offer inclusion in the college description section of the Handbook, does not offer voting privileges, and does not offer inclusion in the Day/Night programs.
