Full-time scholars can receive up to \$6,000 per school year (potential summer funding & limited part-time spaces available)

workshops

Interactive and empowering workshops and personal and professional development activities focused on scholar areas of interest

Your scholar mentor will provide you with personalized coaching and support throughout your education

community

Meet other Forward Steps scholars and build an inclusive community

You are eligible if you:

- Have verifiable experience in the foster care system
- Apply before your 26th birthday
- Are a resident of Colorado and plan to attend, or are currently attending, one of our partnering colleges in the Denver metro, Longmont, Fort Collins, or Greeley areas. See application on www.forwardsteps.org for full list. Other Colorado colleges will be considered.
- Have a high school diploma or a GED before beginning your first semester of college.
- Meet federal financial aid requirements and have unmet need as determined by the FAFSA.
