## What do I receive?

Being a Forward Steps Scholar means:

### **scholarship**

Full-time scholars can receive up to \$6,000 per school year (potential summer funding & limited part-time spaces available)

### **workshops**

Interactive and empowering workshops and personal and professional development activities focused on scholar areas of interest

### **support**

Your scholar mentor will provide you with personalized coaching and support throughout your education and with your post-grad transition

### **community**

Meet other Forward Steps scholars and build an inclusive community

## You are eligible if you:

- Have verifiable experience in the foster care system
- Apply before your 26<sup>th</sup> birthday
- Are a resident of Colorado and plan to attend, or are currently attending, one of our partnering colleges in the Denver metro, Longmont, Fort Collins, or Greeley areas. - Have a high school diploma or a GED before beginning your first semester of college.
- Meet federal financial aid requirements and have unmet need as determined by the FAFSA.
